WELCOME TO SKATE MARTENSVILLE!

This brochure was developed to help skaters and parents understand the many aspects of our club's Spring Ice Sessions. Please take time to read this document and familiarize yourself with the information and what will be expected from you as a participant of our club.

SPRING SESSION OPTIONS

Open Sessions

- Open to skaters in PreSTAR (Canskate Stage 5 or 6), STARSkate and Adult Skate.
- Figure skates only.
- PreSTAR skaters must wear a helmet until completed Stage 5 as per [Skate Canada's Helmet Use Policy](#).
- Sessions do not include coaching unless otherwise stated. Skaters are responsible for booking their own lessons with a coach.
- BYOC (Bring Your Own Coach) is permitted if the coach is a Skate Canada Accredited Coach in good standing. The coach's name must be provided at the time of registration. **Failure to notify Skate Martensville of a coach may result in revoking permission to skate/coach on Skate Martensville sessions.**
- Max 20 participants per session.
- Open Sessions Dates & Times:
 - Mondays, 5:15-7:15 p.m. (April 6-June 22)
 - 12 weeks, 24 sessions; 2 hours/session.
 - Includes one coach-led Stroking session from 7:00-7:15 p.m.
 - Thursdays, 4:30-6:30 p.m. (April 9-June 25)
 - 12 weeks, 24 sessions; 2 hours/session.

Synchro Sessions

- Open to all STARSkate and Adult skaters. Skaters must be minimum STAR 1 OR be 18+ years of age.
 - Figure skates only.
 - All skill levels are welcome. Synchro experience is not required. This is a great opportunity for skaters to try synchro for the first time or for seasoned synchro skaters to refine their skills. Whether you're new to synchro or have years of
-

experience, you'll have the chance to develop technique, build confidence, and enjoy the excitement of synchronized skating!

- Coaching is included.
- Sessions will include team stroking and execution of common synchro elements such as blocks, intersections, wheels, circles, transitions, etc.

 - Thursday, May 14, 6:30-7:30 p.m.

 - Thursday, June 25, 6:30-7:30 p.m.



- All skaters are required to have an active Skate Canada and Skate Saskatchewan membership, which is valid for one year from September 1, 2025 – August 31, 2026.
- Sessions will not be prorated for any circumstances.
- All purchases are final. No refunds.
- Date changes, swaps or transfers to another skater are not allowed.
- Skaters must be registered and paid in full prior to their skating session.
- There is a \$5 admin fee for banking and credit card service charges.

FACILITY

All Spring Ice sessions will be hosted at the [Martensville Recreation Centre](#). The facility officially opened in the fall of 2024 and is located at 100 Main Street West, on the west side of Highway 12. Skaters will have access to a regulation-size ice surface with spectator seating. Designated dressing rooms are available on the main floor, while spectator seating can be accessed on the second floor.

Visitors can also enjoy the many other amenities within the facility including the mini leisure ice, indoor artificial turf facility, indoor rock-climbing wall, indoor playground, and a fully licensed spectator lounge.



CLUB RULES & EXPECTATIONS

Our club keeps the safety of all our members – skaters, coaches, parents and board members – a top priority. Our rules and expectations exist to ensure that your child and all members and guests of Skate Martensville can safely enjoy the club's skating programs in a fun and respectful environment.

1. Courtesy and respect must be demonstrated to all individuals – skaters, coaches, parents, and rink attendants.
 2. Skate guards should be used when skaters leave the ice, for safety reasons.
 3. Proper skating attire should be worn by all skaters.
 4. CanSkaters up to and including Stage 5 MUST wear a CSA-approved hockey helmet as per [Skate Canada's Helmet Use Policy](#).
 5. Dressing rooms must be kept clean and orderly. Trash must be placed in bins provided.

6. Skaters should keep safety in mind at all times:
 - Get up quickly after falling down
 - Look in the direction of travel when skating backwards
 - No pushing, playing tag or bumping into others or the boards
 - No gum or candy on the ice
 - Earbuds, headphones, or similar devices will NOT be permitted on the ice at any time
 - Advise club and/or coaches of any special medical conditions
7. Right of way on the ice:
 - #1: Coaches
 - #2: Skater(s) in a lesson
 - #3: Skater with music playing
8. Please check the TV screen when you come to the rink to find out which dressing room is assigned to your skater.
9. Parents are not allowed on the ice at any time due to insurance reasons. If you need to take your child off the ice, please get the attention of one of the coaches or skaters. Please do not go on the ice.
10. No skater is to be on the ice at the same time as the Zamboni.
11. Skate Martensville reserves the right to revoke privileges of participants and/or coaches who do not follow guidelines or policies.
12. Skate Martensville reserves the right to modify or cancel programs or sessions at any time. Skate Martensville will provide as much cancellation notice as possible via email and social media. Please ensure your Uplifter account settings allow emails from Skate Martensville.
13. A Skate Canada Coach or Skate Martensville Board Member must be in attendance for the session to occur. Skaters must exit the ice if this requirement is not met. No refunds or make-up sessions are provided.
